2 February

Briefing at 19:00 at the Town Hall in Ornex (F).

Each participating artist will receive a map showing the path along which the exhibition will take place.

31 March

Deadline for submission of entries.

16 April

The Organizing Committee will send a confirmation to the artists whose works have been selected.

15 May

Deadline for the artists to inform the organizing committee of the location where they wish their artwork(s) to be exhibited along the path.

31 May

The organizing committee informs the artists of the location finally allocated for the exhibition of their artwork(s) along the path. The committee will take into account the choice of the artist as far as possible, but their decision will also be influenced by the order of arrival of folders, the distribution of the artworks along the path, etc.

18 to 20 June

Installation of the artworks by the artists.

26 June

Preview at 11.30 at Ornex (chemin de Bossy).

5 September

Awards ceremony and closure of the exhibition at Collex (esplanade of the town hall).

10 to 12 September

Dismantling of the exhibition: It is imperative that artists have removed their artworks by 14 September 2018.

Notes

Several cash prizes will be awarded by the judges at the end of the exhibition.

Each artist participating in the 8th exhibition 2021 will receive the catalogue of the exhibition.

The page containing the description of the artistic process and the CV will be placed beside each work exhibited as well as in the catalogue and on the website: www.artencampagne.org

Please note that the artworks will be exposed to the elements and could be damaged in the event of severe weather conditions and that the exhibition is neither secured nor supervised.

Each exhibiting artist is responsible for the installation of his/her artwork(s) at the place determined by the organizing committee and for its/their removal on the dates indicated. The artist should also ensure that his/her artwork is sufficiently secured when a strong wind is blowing.

Each artist must provide by no later than **31 March 2021** a folder comprising:

The form duly completed describing his/her project(s), together with sketches or photos of these.

A description of the artistic process of his/her project that demonstrates the link with the theme of the 8th exhibition (En équilibre).

This description will be placed beside each work exhibited and included in the catalogue and on the website: www.artencampagne.org

A portfolio or visuals (photos) of some recent artworks created by the artist (only for those participating for the first time).

A short CV.

A photo of the artist for the catalogue.

If available, the artist's website.

If already known (and by latest 15 May), indication of the desired location for his/her work(s) on the map .

NB : The CV and description of the artistic process must fit on a single A4 page. Incomplete folders will not be accepted. Folders will not be returned, unless specifically requested by the artist.
